If the report does not address these fundamentals, it makes no sense to award a contract for the East Region Crisis Stabilization Unit and Sobering Services capital project, whether for Phase 1 preconstruction services or for Phase 2 construction.

We need co-ordinated and rational action. No more jumping the gun before everyone is on board.
