

## SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego will consider for adoption:

AN ORDINANCE ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION TO SECTION 142 OF  
ARTICLE IX OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF ADMINISTRATIVE  
ORDINANCES AND NEW SECTION 18.310 TO THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY  
CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES RELATING TO RECEIVERSHIP  
PROCEEDINGS

This proposed ordinance will authorize the Office of County Counsel to initiate receivership proceedings pursuant to State law at the request of County departments, and recover the costs associated with those receiverships. The proposed ordinance will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for the first reading on Tuesday, December 13, 2022. The proposed ordinance will be presented for adoption on Tuesday, January 10, 2023.

Those wishing to comment may either appear in person at the public forum, via teleconference, or submit written comments, which must be received by the County prior to the forum.
