

**RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO
INITIATE PROCEEDINGS FOR DISSOLUTION OF COUNTY SERVICE
AREA NO. 69**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 25213.6(a), the San Diego County Board of Supervisors (Board) desires to adopt a Resolution of Intention to divest Advanced Life Support (ALS) ambulance transport service powers and dissolve County Service Area No. 69 (CSA 69);

WHEREAS, the proposed change of organization will transfer funding and administrative oversight of ALS ambulance transport service to the City of Santee and Lakeside Fire Protection District to serve as successor agencies;

WHEREAS, the proposed change of organization will better meet current and future demands for ALS ambulance transportation service within the City of Santee, Lakeside Fire Protection District, and surrounding areas by aligning the funding and administrative oversight of service with the governing bodies responsible for providing the service;

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the affected territory are depicted in Exhibit A and are described as identical to the boundaries of CSA 69;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that adoption of the proposed resolution of intention for dissolution of County Service Area No. 69 is subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) but exempt from additional analysis pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment. Sections 15378(b)(4) and (5) also apply because the proposed action involves government fiscal activities that do not involve any commitment to any specific project that may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment and because the proposed action involves organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. Additionally, CEQA Guidelines Section 15320 applies because the proposed action involves a reorganization of local governmental agencies where the changes do not alter the geographical area in which existing powers are exercised; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on August 31, 2021, at 9:00 a.m., in Room 310, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, California.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

- (1) An application is hereby made to the San Diego County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) to initiate the dissolution of CSA 69 and transfer funding and administrative oversight of ALS ambulance transport service to the City of Santee and Lakeside Fire Protection District to serve as successor agencies;
