## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO RELATING TO ADOPTING APPROPRIATION LIMIT FOR COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-22

WHEREAS, Section 7910 of the Government Code provides that a local jurisdiction shall, by resolution, establish its Appropriation Limit pursuant to Article XIII B of the California Constitution at a regularly scheduled meeting or at a noticed special meeting; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 111, adopted by California voters in June 1990, provides that the Board of Supervisors shall adopt the inflation and population factors used to calculate the Appropriation Limit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code Section 7910, the documentation used in the determination of the Appropriation Limit was available to the public on or before August 30,2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby establishes that:

- 1. The Appropriation Limit for Fiscal Year 2021-22 shall be \$6,301,284,018.
- 2. Pursuant to Proposition 111, the change in California Per Capita Income is chosen as the inflation factor, and further, that the population change of San Diego County shall be the population factor used in the calculation of the County of San Diego's Appropriation Limit for the Fiscal Year 2021-22.
- 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
