A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO RELATING TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL ALCOHOL POLICING PARTNERSHIP

WHEREAS, the mission of the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) is to administer the provisions of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act in a manner that fosters and protects the health, safety, welfare, and economic well-being of the people of the State.

WHEREAS, the County of San Diego through the San Diego County Sheriff's Department (Sheriff) desires to undertake a law enforcement support project designated to be funded in part from funds made available through ABC under its Alcohol Policing Partnership (APP) program.

WHEREAS, with the aid of grant funding from the ABC APP, the Sheriff and ABC will work to develop an effective, comprehensive, and strategic approach to eliminating crimes and public nuisances associated with problematic alcoholic beverage outlets and institutionalize the approaches within the law enforcement agency.

WHEREAS, if an amendment to add additional funds is made to the original contract, an additional resolution is not necessary from the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors to accept this additional funding.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego hereby certifies that the:

- 1. Sheriff is authorized to apply for and accept grant funding from the ABC APP in subsequent years provided there are no material changes to the grant terms and/or funding levels.
- 2. Sheriff is authorized to execute all grant-related documents.
- 3. Grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures, and that this award is not subject to local hiring freezes.
