RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING RESULTS OF SPECIAL ELECTION WITHIN PERMANENT ROAD DIVISION NO. 1000, ZONE NO. 13A – PALA MESA ZONE A, COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPOSITION OF A SPECIAL TAX FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE SERVICES AND ORDERING SAID SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE CONSOLIDATED WITH THE NOVEMBER 3, 2026 GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works conducted an informal survey of property owners within Permanent Road Division No. 1000, Zone No. 13A – Pala Mesa Zone A to assess the community’s level of support for a potential special tax, and the results indicated sufficient interest for the County to initiate the Proposition 218 special tax proceedings; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Streets and Highways Code Section 1173 and 1176, the Board on June 24, 2026, called a special tax election and designated the Registrar of Voters as a judge to conduct the election; and

WHEREAS, a special election has been conducted in accordance with the direction provided by the Board on June 24, 2026; and

WHEREAS, a Certificate of Clerk re: Preparation and Distribution of Ballots, Receipt of Executed Ballots and Declaring Election Results, (the "Certificate of Election Results"), executed by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors (the "Clerk"), has been filed with the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received, reviewed and hereby accepts the Clerk's Certificate of Election Results and wishes by this resolution to declare the results of the special election.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of San Diego County as follows:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and the Board so finds and determines.

Section 2. The Board hereby finds and determines and declares that the ballot measure submitted to the qualified electors of Permanent Road Division No. 1000, Zone No. 13A – Pala Mesa Zone A has been passed and approved by those qualified electors in accordance with Article XIII C, Section 4, of the California Constitution, and the Permanent Road Divisions Law, specifically Sections 1173 to 1179 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section 4. The Clerk of the Board shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter into the book of original resolutions.
